- Develop and manage budgets, tracking expenditures and ensure financial compliance.
- Provide regular budget updates to program sponsors and senior leadership.
- Report any potential cost impacts (time, contractor, site changes etc) to relevant personnel.
- Allocate and manage resources effectively, ensuring optimal utilisation and alignment with program priorities.
- Collaborate with resource managers to address resource constraints and optimise program staffing.

Risk Management:

- Identify, assess, and manage program risks, working closely with project teams to develop risk response plans.
- Monitor and communicate program or project risks to stakeholders, providing recommendations for risk mitigation and implement agreed risk reduction strategies.
- Comply with safety regulations, PWC policies, and environmental standards. Ensure personal safety, record non-compliance incidents, and
 protect the environment.

- Implement quality assurance processes to ensure program deliverables meet established standards.
